Speech and Drama



Primary

Reading

Writing

Write text using appropriate tone, style and register and the salient features of different genres in a structured and logical order.

Listening

Understand and identify the key details of a range of spoken texts, interpret speakers' feelings, views, attitudes and intentions.

Speaking

Produce coherent and structured speeches and participate in group discussions with ideas effectively, clearly presented and delivered with accurate pronunciation, appropriate pace, volume, intonation, stress, eye contact and body language.
