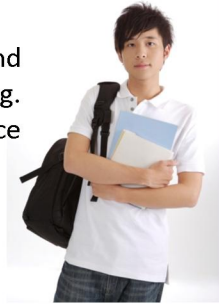
Twice a Week, 6 Week Course

The activities used will aid students' concentration, build confidence and encourage sharing and teamwork.

Public Speaking

This course will introduce students to the basics/in-depth knowledge of Public Speaking. It aims to increase students' confidence in public speaking by empowering students with the organizational, verbal and non-verbal skills essential to giving a memorable presentation or speech.

English for NSS



This course will introduce the basics of each elective in the New Senior Secondary system. The programme will give students an overview of the contents of the electives while developing their English language skills.

Learning English through Drama

Equipping learners with the knowledge and understanding of the basic skills needed for performing in drama and writing scripts.

Learning English through Short Stories

Examine different types of sport-related text leading on to writing practice. Writing activities will cover fan pages/player profiles, sport articles etc.

Learning English through Debating

Understand the fundamental ideas and the basic set up of debating as well as the idea of rhetoric.

Reading

Identify and interpret the purpose and meaning of a broad range of texts. Identify the main theme, key details, contextual meaning of the text and interpret the writer's feelings and opinion.

Writing

Write text using appropriate tone, style and register and the salient features of different genres in a structured and logical order.

Listening

Understand and identify the key details of a range of spoken texts, interpret speakers' feelings, views, attitudes and intentions.

Speaking

Produce coherent and structured speeches and participate in group discussions with ideas effectively, clearly presented and delivered with accurate pronunciation, appropriate pace, volume, intonation, stress, eye contact and gesture etc.
